## Narrative Medicine in Practice 2024

The <u>German Network of Narrative Medicine</u> invites to a special event within the 2024 series "Narrative Medizin in der Praxis":

On July 1, 2024, at 18-20 o'clock (CET), John Launer will join Anita Wohlmann for an introduction to "Conversations Inviting Change," a narrative-based approach that is informed by family systems therapy and narrative therapy, among many other influences.

John Launer is a former family physician who now works as a medical educator and writer. With "Conversations Inviting Change," he and his team focus on narratives of real cases and dilemmas, combined with an interactional method that involves, as Launer explains, "close listening and focused questioning in order to create space for new thoughts and resolutions to emerge. We teach people that stories have their own momentum: You don't need to interpret what people say or nudge them in any direction, just allow them to breathe new life into their own stories."

Anita Wohlmann is completing a "train the trainer" course with CIC and will use the meeting to introduce the technique to members of the German network, with other interested colleagues being warmly invited.

The 2-hour online meeting will be in English and will include short lectures and active case work, both in plenary style and in small groups.
